Deltamethrin Pesticides — Specification — Part 3: Dustable Powder

1 Scope

This working draft specifies the requirements for dustable powder of deltamethrin used for agricultural purpose.

2 Normative references

The following documents are referred to in the text in such a way that some or all of their content constitutes requirements of this document. For dated references, only the edition cited applies. For undated references, the latest edition of the referenced document (including any amendments) applies.

3 Terms and definitions

For the purposes of this standard, the terms and definitions given in RS 406 apply.

4 Requirements

4.1 Active ingredients

4.1.1 Identity test

Where the identity of the active ingredient is in doubt, determine in accordance with WD xxx then the isolated active ingredient shall comply with at least one additional test.

4.1.2 Deltamethrin

The deltamethrin content shall be declared (g/kg) and, when determined in accordance with WD xxx, the content obtained shall not differ from that declared by more than the following amounts:

Declared content in g/kg at 20 ± 2°C	Tolerance limit	
<25	± 15% of the declared content	
>25	± 10% of the declared content	

NOTE 1- The deltamethrin content in wettable powders does not exceed 100 g/kg.

4.2 General requirements

- **4.2.1** The material shall consist of a homogeneous mixture of technical deltamethrin complying with the requirements of WD xxx-1 together with filler(s) and any other necessary formulants.
- 4.2.2 It shall be in the form of a fine powder free from visible extraneous matter and hard lumps.

4.3 Specific requirements

4.3.1 The product shall comply with the requirements given in table 1 when tested in accordance with the methods prescribed therein.

iii.	Alkalinity (as NaOH), g/kg	2	
iv.	Dry sieve test, % by mass, max., amount retained on a 150µm test sieve	2	
V.	Dustability, at 54°C	the powder shall issue freely without clogging or bridging	

4.3.2 Storage stability at 54°C

When determined in accordance with xxx, after storage at 54 \pm 2°C for 14 days, the productshall comply with the requirements of 4.1.1, 4.3.1 (i) and (iv).

5 Packaging

The product shall be packaged in accordance with RS 565-1.

6 Labelling and marking

The labelling and marking of the product shall be done in accordance with DRS 578.

Retail, distribution, storage and handling

The product shall be handled in accordance with DRS 579.

NOTE Attention is drawn to the appropriate national and/ or international regulations on the handling and transport of flammable materials.

Disposal

Disposal of bulk quantities of obsolete pesticides shall be in accordance with DRS 589.
